

## **SUPPLIES:**

- Fine (4ply)yarn yarnart Jeans (55%cotton, 45% acrylic, 160m/50g)
- 2mm crochethook
- Pink embroidery floss fo nose
- Fiberfill for stuffing
- Some wire for arms (optional)
- 10mm safety eyes
- Two Buttons for shoes
- Long large eye needles

## **ABBREVIATIONS:**

- ch=chain
- st=stitch
- sc = single crochet
- inc = increase (2 sc in one st)
- dec = decrease (2 s¢ together)
- sl st = slip stitch
- hdc = half double crochet

# ARMS (MAKE 2):

Crochet with white yarn.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in magic ring [6]

Rnd 2: (inc) repeat 6 times [12]

Rnd 3-4: sc in all 12 st [12]

Stuff the bottom part of the arm slightly.


Rnd 5: (dec) repeat 3 times, sc in next 6 st [9]

Rnd 6: sc in next st, inc, sc in next 7 st [10]



Rnd 7-20 [14 rounds]: sc in all 10 st [10]

Finish with s! st. Fasten off and leave a tail for sewing,



# LEGS (MAKE 2):

Crochet 9 ch with white yarn. Continue working around the foundation chain, beginning from the 2nd ch from the hook.

Rnd 1: sc next 7 st, 3 sc in last st, turn, sc in next 6 st, inc [18]

Rnd 2: (inc) x 2 times, sc in next 4 st, (inc) x 5 times, sc in next 4 st, (inc) x 3 times [28]

Rnd 3: (sc in next st, inc) repeat 2 times, sc in next 4 st, (sc in next st, inc) repeat 5 times, sc in next 4 st, (sc in next st, inc) repeat 3 times [38]

Rnd 4: (sc in next 2 st, inc) repeat 2 times, sc in next 4 st, (sc in next 2 st, inc) repeat 5 times, sc in next 4 st, (sc in next 2 st inc) repeat 3 times [48]

Rnd 5-7: sc in all 48 st [48]

Rnd 8: (sc in next 6 st, dec) repeat 6 times [42]

Rnd 9: sc in next 12 st, (dec) repeat 9 times, sc in next 12 st [33]

Rnd 10: (sc in next 9 st, dec) repeat 3 times [30]

Rnd 11: se in next 9 st, (dec) repeat 6 times, sc in next 9 st [24]

Rnd 12: (sc in next 2 st, dec) repeat 6 times [18]

Stuff firmly with fiberfill. To get better balance add some weight (small stones, poly pellets, etc.)



Rnd 13: sc in next 3 st, (dec) repeat 6 times, sc in next 3 st [12]

Rnd 14-15: sc in all 12 st [12]

Rnd 16: (sc in next 3 st, inc) repeat 3 times [15]

Rnd 17-20: sc in all 15 st [15]

Rnd 21: (sc in next 4 st, inc) repeat 3 times [18]

Rnd 22-25: sc in all 18 st [18]

Finish with s! st. Fasten off and weave in the end. To strengthen the ankle insert cotton swab or round wooden stick in the leg (the bottom part of the stick s located in the foot) and stuff it with fiberfill.



Make the second leg in the same way, but don't fasten off. Continue working on the body.

# **BODY**:

Stuff the body as you go. Begin crocheting from the middle point of the inner side of the left leg.

Rnd 26: (sc in next 5 st, inc) repeat 3 times, 3 ch, on the right leg (from the inner side): (sc in next 5 st, inc) repeat 3 times.

Rnd 27: sc in next 3 ch, sc in next 21 st, sc in next 3 ch on the opposite side, sc in next 21 st [48]





Rnd 28-34: sc in all 48 st [48]

Rnd 35: (sc in next 6 st, dec) repeat 6 times [42]

Rnd 36-37: sc in all 42 st [42]

Rnd 38: (sc in next 5 st, dec) repeat 6 times [36]

Rnd 39-40: sc in all 36 st [36]

Rnd 41: (sc in next 4 st, dec) repeat 6 times [30]

Rnd 42-43: sc in all 30 st [30]

Rnd 44: (sc in next 3 st, dec) repeat 6 times [24]


Rnd 45: sc in all 24 st [24]

If you want the arms to be bendable, make a simple wire carcass. Insert it in the next round like it's shown in the picture.



Rnd 46: (sc in next 2 st,dec) repeat 6 times [18]





Rnd 47-49: sc in all 18 st [18]

Rnd 50: (sc in next st, dec) repeat 6 times [12]

Finish with sl st. Fasten off and leave a tail for sewing,

If the wire has no coating it's better to wrap it with fabric sticking tape before sewing the arms.



**TAIL** 

Work with white yam.

Rnd 1: 6 sein magic ring [6]

Rnd 2: (inc) repeat 6 times [12]

Rnd3: sc all 12 st [12]



Rnd 4: (sc in next 2 st, dec) repeat 3 times [9]

Finish with sl st. Fasten off and leave a tail for sewing.

Sew the tail to the body, adding some fiberfill inside the tail before you finish.

# **HEAD**

Crochet with white yarn.

Rnd 1: 6 sein magic ring [6]

Rnd 2: (inc) repeat 6 times [12]

Rnd 3: (sc in next st, inc) repeat 6 times [18]

Rnd 4: (sc in next 2 st, inc) repeat 6 times [24]

Rnd 5: (sc in next 3 st, inc) repeat 6 times [30]

Rnd 6: (sc in next 4 st, inc) repeat 6 times [36]

Rnd7: sc all 36 st [36]

Rnd 8: (sc in next 5 st, inc) repeat 6 times [42]

Rnd9: sc all 42 st [42]

Rnd 10: (sc in next 6 st, inc) repeat 6 times [48]

Rnd 11-14: sc all 48 st [48]

Rnd 15: (inc in front loop) repeat 12 times, sc in next 4 st, (inc in front loop) repeat 12 times, sc in next 20 st [72]

Rnd 16: sc all 72 st [72]

Rnd 17: sc in next 52 st, dec, sc in next 16 st, dec [70]

Rnd 18: sc in next 52 st, dec, sc in next 14 st, dec [68]

Rnd 19: sc in next 52 st, dec, sc in next 12 st, dec [66]

Find Rnd15 on the muzzle. Then find 4 sc between the increases. This is the center of the muzzle. Take in into account When placing the eyes.

Insert safety eyes between Rnd 14 and Rnd 15, at 10 st in between the eyes. Donit fasten the eyes with caps, as they can prevent from making muzzle indents. You will secure the eyes with a drop of crystal glue when the indents are done.



Rnd 20: sc in next 52 st, dec, sc in next 10 st, dec [64]

Rnd 21: scin next 52 st, dec, sc in next 8 st, dec [62]

Rnd 22: sc in next 52 st, dec, sc in next 6 st, dec [60]

Rnd 23: sc in all 60 st [60]

Rnd 24: (sc in next 8 st, dec) repeat 6 times [54]

Rnd 25: (sc in next 2 st, dec) repeat 5 times, sc in next 8 st, (dec, sc in next 2 st) repeat 6 times, dec [42]


Rnd 26: (sc in next st, dec) repeat 5 times, sc in next 8 st, (dec, sc in next st) repeat 5 times, (dec) repeat 2 times [30]

Rnd 27: (sc in next 3 st, dec) repeat 6 times [24]

Rnd 28: (sc in next 2 st, dec) repeat 6 times [18]

Rnd 29: (sc in next st, dec) repeat 6 times [12]

Finish with s! st. Fasten off and weave in the end. Stuff tightly.



Marking the main muzzle points:

Mark the nose with pins symmetrically in relation to the eyes - 6 sc in width and 2 rnds in height

« Upper points are between Rnd 15 and Rnd 16.

« Lower points are between Rnd 17 and Rnd 18



Mark the mouth with pins slightly aside from the nose (please look at the picture):

- « Pin #5 is placed between Rnd 20 and Rnd 21.
- « Pin #6 is placed between Rnd 21 and Rnd 22.
- \* Pin #7 is placed between Rnd 22 and Rnd 23
- « Pin #8 is placed between Rnd 23 and Rnd 24.

# **Eye points:**

- \* Point #1 is located under the left safety eye from the left.
- \* Point #2 is located under the left safety eye from the right
- \*Point #3 is located under the right safety eye from the right.
- \* Point #4 is located under the right safety eye from the left.

# **Making muzzle indents:**

Step 1. Take a long needie with white thread, make a knot at the end of the thread. Insert the needle from the inside (through the neck hole) and draw it out the Point 1. Step down a little bit (to seize the stitch) and insert the needle near the Point #1, then draw it out the Point #3. Pull slightly.



Step 2. Insert the needle in the Point #4, and draw it out the Point #2. Pull slightly.





Step 3. Step down a little bit and insert the needle near the Point #2, and draw the needle out the Point #5.



Step 4. Insert the needle in the Point #6 and draw it out the Point #1. Pull slightly.





Step5.Insert the needle in the Point #2 and draw the needle out the Point #4. Pull slightly



Step 6. Insert the needle at the Point #4, and draw it out the Point #7.



Step7. Insert the needle in the Point #3 and draw it out the neck hole. Pull slightly and fasten off.





Step 8. Insert the needle in the Point s3, and draw it outthe neck hole. Pull slightly and fasten off.

# **Embroidering a smile:**

- Step 1. Take the needle with gray or black thread, make a knot at the end of the thread, and insert it in the Point #6 from the inside.
- Step 2. Insert the needle in the Point #8 and draw it out the neck hole, forming a smile stitch.
- Step 3. Again insert the needle in the Point #6 from the inside. Draw it out.
- Step 4. Insert the needle in the Point #5 and draw it out the Point #8.
- Step 5. Insert the needle in the Point #7 and draw it out the neck hole.

Fasten off and cut off the thread.







# Embroidering a nose.

Check that nose pins are in place after making indents. Correct their location if its needed.

Step 1. Embroider the borderlines of the nose. Check that the stitches are even.



Step 2. Embroider the second layer with vertical stitches very neatly and evenly. Insert the needle into the toy right between the rounds, giving the nose a nice shape. Hide the end inside the toy and fix it





The head is done! To fix the eyes reliably , glue them to the head with a dropo of the Crystal glue (optional)



EARS (MAKE 2):

Work with white yarn. Don't stuff.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in magic ring [6]

Rnd 2: (inc) repeat 6 times [12]

RNd 3: inc 3 times, sc in next 3 st) repeat 2 times [18]

Rnd 4: sc in the st inc) repeat 3 times, sc in next 3 st (sc in next st, inc) repeat 3 times, sc in next 3 st [24]

Rnd 5: sc in next 5 st,inc, sc in next 11 st, inc, sc in next 6 st [26]



RNd 6: sc in next 5 st, (inc) x 2 times, sc in next 11 st, (inc) x 2 times, sc n next 6 st 30]

Rnd 7: sc in all 30 st [30]

RNd 8: sc in next 6 st,(inc) x 2 times, sc in next 13 st, (inc) x 2 times, sc in next 7 st 34]

Rnd 9:sc in all 34 st [24]

Rnd 10:sc i next 7 st (inc) x 2 times, sc in next 15 st, (inc) x 2 times, sc in next 8 st [38]

Rnd 11-32 [22 rounds]: sc in all 38 st [38]

Fasten off and leave a tal for sewing



Fold the ears like its shown in the picture and pin them on the top of the head, then sew them on.







# PRETTY BUNNY'S CLOTHES CROCHET PATTERN (BOW + DRESS + SHOES)

# **Dress crochet pattern:**

## **Belt:**

Crochet 57 ch with light pink yarn.

Row 1: dc in next 55 ch, starting from the 3rd ch from the hook [55]

To make the upper part of the dress: turn and make 2 sl st on the side of the last dc st, continue working on the opposite

side of the foundation chain.

**Note**: Crochet in ending straight rows, turn and start each following row with 1 ch.

Row 1-6: sc in all 55 st [55]

Row 7: (sc in next 8 st, dec) repeat 2 times, (sc in next 7 st, dec) repeat 3 times, sc in next 8 st [50]

Row 8: sc in all 50 st [50]

Row 9: sc in next 6 st, dec, (sc in next 7 st, dec) repeat 4 times, sc in next 6 st [45]

Row 10: sc in all 45 st

Row 11: (sc in next 6 st, dec) repeat 5 times, sc in next 5 st [40]

Row 12: sc in next 6 st, 10 ch, skip 8 st for the sleeve, sc in next 12 st, 10 ch, skip 8 st for another sleeve, sc in next 6 st.

Row 13: sc in next 6 st, sc in next 10 ch, sc in next 12 st, sc in next 10 ch, sc in next 6 st [44]

Row 14: sc in next 5 st, dec, sc in next 8 st, dec, sc in next 10 st, dec, sc in next 8 st, dec, sc in next 5 st [40]

Row 15: sc in next 4 st, dec, (sc in next 3 st, dec) repeat 2 times, sc in next 8 st, dec, (sc in next 3 st, dec) repeat 2 times, sc in next 4 st [34]

Row 16: sc in next 4 st, dec, (sc in next 2 st, dec) repeat 2 times, sc in next 6 st, dec, (sc in next 2 st, dec) repeat 2 times, sc in next 4 st [28]



Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing.

Join light pink yarn to the back loop of the belt and crochet a bottom part of the dress:

Row 1: sc in all 55 st in back loops only. Fasten off.

Go back to the beginning of Row 1 and attach pink yarn to the back loop.

Row 2: crochet in back loops only (sc in next 17 st, inc) repeat 3 times, sc in next st [58]

Sew the edges of the bottom part of the dress together and continue working on the frill.



# Frill (make 3 in light pink, blue and bright pink colors):

Use three rows of front loops on the bottom part of the dress to crochet frill. Each frill consists of 2 rounds.

Rnd 1: inc in each loop till the end of the round, join with sl st.

Rnd 2: (sc in next st, inc) repeat till the end of the round. Fasten off and hide the tail.

Sew on 3-4 buttons on the left back side of the dress, and make the loops for these buttons on the opposite side. You can find a video tutorial here >> How to Make a Hand Stitched Button Loop in the blog.





Sew the head to the body. To strengthen the neck, insert 3-4 cotton swabs or round wooden stick in it (the upper part of the stick is in the head, and the bottom part is in the body). Add some fiberfill in the neck before you finish

# **SHOES:**

Crochet 9 ch with gray yarn. Continue working around the foundation chain, beginning from the second ch from the hook.

Rnd 1: scin next 7 st, 3 sc in next st, turn, sc in next 6 st, inc [18]

Rnd 2: inc, sc in next 6 st, (inc) x 3 times, sc in next 6 st, (inc) x 2 times [24]

Rnd 3: sc in next st, inc, sc in next 6 st, (sc in next st, inc) repeat 3 times, sc in next 6 st, (sc in next st, inc) repeat 2 times [30]

Rnd 4: sc in next 2 st, inc, sc in next 6 st, (sc in next 2 st, inc) repeat 3 times, sc in next 6 st, (sc in next 2 st, inc) repeat 2 times [36]

Rnd 5: sc in next 3 st, inc, sc in next 6 st, (sc in next 3 st, inc) repeat 3 times, sc in next 6 st, (sc in next 3 st, inc) repeat 2 times [42]

Rnd 6: sc in next 4 st, inc, sc in next 6 st, (sc in next 4 st, inc) repeat 3 times, sc in next 6 st, sc in next 4 st, inc, sc in next 2 st, inc, sc in next st, sl st in next st [48]

## Change to bright pink yarn.

Rnd 7: sc in all 48 st in back loops only [48]

Rnd 8-10: sc in all 48 st [48]

Rnd 11: sc in next 6 st, dec, sc in next 2 st, dec, sc in next 20 st, dec, sc in next 2 st, dec, sc in next 10 st [44]

Place the marker in the middle of the back part of the shoe, and start the next round from this point.



Rnd 12: sc in next 12 st, hdc in next 3 st, (dc dec, dc in next 2 st) x 3 times, dc dec, hdc in next 3 st, sc in next 12 st [40]

Finish with sl st. Fasten off and hide the end



FLOWER (MAKE 2):

Crochet in magic ring (2 ch, 2 tr, 2 ch, 1 sc) x 5 times.

Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing.

Sew the flower on the shoe like it's shown in the picture. Sew on the button in the center of the flower.



**BOW:** 

Make 26 ch with light pink yarn. Continue working in rows from the 2nd ch from the hook

Row 1: sc in next 25 st [25]



Row 2-10: 1 ch, sc in next 25 st [25]

Join blue yarn and crochet sc along the edges of the rectangle.

# Center part of the bow:

Crochet 10 ch with blue yarn.

Rnd 1: sc in next 8 ch beginning from the 2nd ch from the hook, 3 sc in last ch, turn and work on the opposite side: sc in the next 7 st, inc [20]

Fasten off with sl st, leave the tail for sewing.

Wrap this blue part around the center of the bow and sew the edges together on the opposite side of the bow. Sew on the bow near the ears.
