


#### MATERIALS:

- 3.00 mm crochet hook (US C)
- 100 % cotton yarn for a 3.00 mm hook
- A pair of 8 mm safety eyes
- Tapestry needle
- Polyfiber fill

GAUGE: Rounds 1-4 measure about 1 1/2"

#### STITCH ABBREVIATIONS

- st = Stitch
- ch = Chain
- slst = Slip Stitch
- sc = Single Crochet
- hdc = Half Double Crochet
- dc = Double Crochet
- BLO = Back Loop Only



#### Youre gonna need it:

One color for the skin, gray for the hair, white for the panties and one of the flowers on the hat, the color of your choice for the coat and hat (I chose light blue) and black for the shoes, bag and others Details. And a little rose to embroider the cheeks and the other flower on her hat. Use 100% cotton yarn.

Final Size: From head to toe, Queen Elizabeth measures approximately 23 cm.

Of course, if you choose a different needle and yarn, the final measurements will vary.

#### Ready? Let's start!



Queen Elizabeth is knitted from her little legs to her head in spirals... So you make the coat last...

## LEG 1

{Start with black, for her shoes.}

- 1. 6sc on a magic ring
- 2. Crochet \*6 inc\*, repeat \* (12)
- 3. Crochet 12sc
- 5. Change to skin color in, BLO, crochet 12sc
- 6. Crochet 12sc
- 9. Change to white (underwear) in, BLO, crochet 12sc
- Finish off

LEG 2 + BODY

{Start with black, for her shoes.}

- 1. 6sc on a magic ring
- 2. Crochet \*6 inc\*, repeat \* (12)
- 3. to 4. Crochet 12sc
- 5. Change to skin color in, BLO, crochet 12sc
- 6. to 8. Crochet 12sc
- 9. Change to white (underwear) in, BLO, crochet 12sc

DON'T BREAK THE YARN... Now let's start with the body...





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### BODY

10. (This is the tricky part...) Still with leg 2 on the needle, 3 ch and join leg 1 with a sc.

#### This will be the new start of the next laps. Crochet farther 11sc along leg

Then crochet 3sc on one side of the 3 ch.Now crochet 12sc along leg 2 and finally 3sc across the 3rd ch. Total points: 30

- 11. Crochet \*4sc, 1 inc\*, repeat \* (36)
- 12. to 16. Crochet 36sc
- 17. Crochet \*4sc, 1 dec\*, repeat \* (30)
- 18. to 20. Crochet 30sc

#### {Inflate your legs firmly...}

- 21. Crochet \*3sc, 1 dec\*, repeat \* (24)
- 22. to 23. Crochet 24sc
- 24. Crochet \*2sc, 1 dec\*, repeat \* (18)

#### {Fill the body firmly...}

- 25. to 27. Crochet 18sc
- 28. Crochet \*1sc, 1 dec\*, repeat \* (12)
- 29. Change to light blue (dress) and crochet 12sc
- 30. Change to black (necklace) and, BLO, crochet 12sc
- 31. Change to skin color and, BLO, crochet 12sc

#### DO NOT BREAK THE YARN! Now let's continue with the head

#### HEAD


- 32. Crochet \*12 inc\*, repeat \* (24)
- 33. Crochet \*3sc, 1 inc\*, repeat \* (30)

## { Firmly fill the neck area...}

- 34. Crochet \*4sc, 1 inc\*, repeat \* (36)
- 35. Crochet \*5sc, 1 inc\*, repeat \* (42)

36. Crochet 42sc

37. Crochet 24sc, then for nose, popcorn stitch with 4dc (see instructions) then 17sc (this is approximate. Be sure to line up the nose with the middle of her legs!!!)



And now let's make the coat collar before we continue with the head...

#### COAT COLLAR

{Turn Queen Elizabeth's body upside down (unfinished head down...again!) and join the black thread in one of the front loops of the 31st loop of the body, once again at the back of the neck, where the color change starts... }

# (NOTE: when you see instructions between [...], it means you need to crochet all the stitches between the square brackets into the same stitch.)

1. Crochet 1sc in each of the front loops of round 31 (12)

2. Now crochet the following stitches: 4sc, [1hdc + 1 dc], [3dc], 1 sl st, [1 sl st, 2 ch, 2 pair in 2 ch], [1 dc + 1hdc], 3sc Finish off.

#### Now, let's continue with the head, please!

{ Using her skin color, go back to where you he left ...}

38. - 46. Crochet 42pb

47. Crochet \*5sc, 1 dc\*, repeat \* (36)

{Start filling your head...}


48. Crochet \*4sc, 1 dc\*, repeat \* (30)

STOP!! Let's pause here and start crocheting the coat because it will be easier to do it without the head interfering... Put a stitch marker on the last stitch so it doesn't come out and cut the yarn from the ball, do not worry. We'll come back to that later.

## COAT

{{NOTE: Turn Queen Elizabeth's body upside down (unfinished head down!) and attach the color you chose for her coat to one of the front loops of loop 30, right at the back of her neck ...}

- 1. Crochet \*1sc, 1 inc\*, repeat \* (18)
- 2. 3. Crochet 18sc
- 4. Crochet \*2sc, 1 inc\*, repeat \* (24)
- 5. 6. Crochet 24sc
- 7. Crochet \*3sc, 1 inc\*, repeat \* (30)
- 8. 11. Crochet 30sc
- 12. Crochet \*4sc, 1 inc\*, repeat \* (36)
- 13. -to 15. Crochet 36sc





16. Crochet \*5sc, 1 inc\*, repeat \* (42)

#### Ready? Let's continue then...

{ Place the safety eyes a circle above the nose (the distance between the eyes is 8 stitches) and embroider the cheeks with a little pink thread...}

49. Crochet \*3sc, 1 dec\*, repeat \* (24)

50. Crochet \*2sc, 1 dec\*, repeat \* (18)

#### { fill tightly.}

- 51. Crochet \*1sc, 1 dec\*, repeat \* (12)
- 52. Crochet 6 dec (6) Fasten off.

#### ARMS

#### {Do two, starting with her skin color...}

- 1. Crochet 2 ch 4sc in 2nd ch.
- 2. Crochet \*4 inc\*, repeat \* (8)
- 3. to 5. Crochet 8sc
- 6- Change to black and, BLO, crochet 8sc
- 7. Crochet 8sc
- 8. Change to coat color (light blue) and, BLO, crochet 8sc
- 9. to 17. Crochet 8sc

#### {fill only half of the arm...}

18. Press the opening with your fingers, aligning 4 stitches side by side and 1sc together the corresponding stitches, 1sc in each pair of stitches. Close and break the yarn, leaving a long tail to sew to the body.

HAIR

## {Use gray...}

- 1. 6sc on a magic ring
- 2. Crochet \*6 inc\*, repeat \* (12)
- 3. Crochet \*1sc, 1 aum\*, repeat \* (18)
- 4. Crochet \*2sc, 1 aum\*, repeat \* (24)
- 5. Crochet \*3sc, 1 aum\*, repeat \* (30)
- 6. Crochet \*4sc, 1 aum\*, repeat \* (36)
- 7. Crochet \*5sc, 1 aum\*, repeat \* (42)
- 8. Crochet \*13sc, 1 aum\*, repeat \* (45)
- 9. to 16. Crochet 45sc

17. Crochet 1 sl st, 6sc, 1hdc, 10 dc, 1hdc, 6sc and 1 sl st. Now let's start with the short curls: 9 ch st. Insert hook into second channel of needle and crochet 1sc. Then crochet 1sc in each stitch along the chain, until you reach the edge of the hair piece (**you will end up with 8sc**). The curls will curl naturally as you do \*1 sl st

#### HAT

{Start with the same color as the coat...}

- 1. 6sc on a magic ring
- 2. Crochet \*6 inc\*, repeat \* (12)
- 3. Crochet \*2sc in each st\*, repeat \* (24)






- 4. Crochet \*3sc, 1 inc\*, repeat \* (30)
- 5. Crochet \*4sc, 1 inc\*, repeat \* (36)
- 6. Crochet \*5sc, 1 inc\*, repeat \* (42)
- 7. Crochet \*2sc, 1 inc\*, repeat \* (56)
- 8. Crochet 56sc
- 9. BLO, crochet 56sc
- 10. Crochet \*6sc, 1 dec\*, repeat \* (49)
- 11. to 15. Crochet 49 sc
- 16. BLO and crochet 49 sc
- 17. Crochet 49 sc
- 18. BLO, \*1sc, 1 inc\*, repeat \* (73)
- 19. Crochet 73sc
- 20. Crochet 1sc ,\*2sc, 1 inc\*, repeat \* (98)
- 20. Crochet 98 sl st

#### ASSEMBLY

- Sew the hair to the head.
- Sew the arms to the sides of the body.
- Sew the flowers to the hat, right on the left!
- Place the black bag on her arm and sew it into position with a few stitches.
- Weave in all ends inside your doll.



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1 - Start with 5sc on the magic ring. Then crochet 1 sl st in next stitch, 2ch...



3 - Thread the thread, pull it through two loops on the Hook




2 - Insert the needle at the same point, pull the thread through



4 - Thread the yarn through, insert the needle into the same stitch, and pull the yarn through...

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5 – Thread the yarn, pull it through two loops on the needle...



6 - Thread the yarn, pull it through the three remaining loops on the hook, 2 ch, 1 sl st in the same st \*, repeat \* 5 times.
