## SKILL LEVEL - Easy

## SIZES

Cloud: About $41 / 2 \mathrm{in}$. $(11.5 \mathrm{~cm})$ tall
Rainbow: About $51 / 2 \mathrm{in} .(14 \mathrm{~cm})$ tall
Sun: About 5 in. ( 12.5 cm ) tall
Raindrop: About 2 in. ( 5 cm ) tall

## MATERIALS

- Lion Brand $®^{8}$ Feels Like Butta (Art. \#215)
- \#100 White 1 ball (A)
- \#157 Yellow 1 ball (B)
- \#146 Lilac 1 ball (C)
- \#108 Dusty Blue 1 ball (D)
- \#156 Mint 1 ball (E)
- \#158 Lemon 1 ball (F)
- \#140 Dusty Pink 1 ball (G)
- Crochet hook size G-6 (4 mm)
- Stitch markers

- Large-eyed blunt needle


## ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

- Fiberfill stuffing
- Embroidery hoops, one about 6 in . $(15 \mathrm{~cm})$ in diameter, the other about 10 in . $(25.5 \mathrm{~cm})$ in diameter


## GAUGE

$16 \mathrm{sc}+18$ rows = about 4 in. $(10 \mathrm{~cm})$
EXACT GAUGE IS NOT ESSENTIAL FOR THIS PROJECT.

## STITCH EXPLANATIONS

picot Ch 3, sl st in 3rd ch from hook.
sc2tog (sc 2 sts together) (Insert hook in next st and draw up a loop) twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook - 1 st decreased.

## NOTES

1. 4 Clouds, 5 Raindrops, 1 Sun, and a Rainbow are each worked separately.
2. The embroidery hoops are tied together to make the mobile and then pieces are tied to hoop frame.
3. To change yarn color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete st. Proceed with new color. Fasten off old color.
4. The gauge is meant to be a bit tight - this helps keep the stuffing from poking through.

## CLOUD PANELS (Make 8)

With A, ch 13.

Row 1 (RS): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across - you will have 12 sc in this row.
Row 2: Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, sc in next 10 sts, 2 sc in last st - 14 sc .
Row 3: Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, sc in next 12 sts, 2 sc in last st -16 sc .
Row 4: Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, sc in next 14 sts, 2 sc in last st -18 sc .
Rows 5 and 6: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.
Row 7: Turn, sc2tog, sc in next 14 sts, sc2tog - 16 sc.
Row 8: Turn, sc2tog, sc in next $12 \mathrm{sts}, \mathrm{sc} 2 \mathrm{tog}-14 \mathrm{sc}$.
Row 9: Turn, sc2tog, sc in next $10 \mathrm{sts}, \mathrm{sc} 2 \mathrm{tog}-12 \mathrm{sc}$.
Rnd 10: Ch 1, do not turn; working in ends of rows along side edge, 6 dc in end of Row 7, sl st in end of Row 5,6 dc in end of Row 3; working along opposite side of foundation ch, sl st in first ch, sk next ch, 6 dc in next ch, sk next 2 ch , sl st in next ch, sk next $2 \mathrm{ch}, 6 \mathrm{dc}$ in next ch, sk next 2 ch , sl st in next ch; working in ends of rows along next side edge, 6 dc in end of Row 4 , sl st in end of Row $6,6 \mathrm{dc}$ in end of Row 8; working in sts of Row 9, sl st in first st, sk next st, 6 dc in next st, sk next 2 sts, sl st in next st, sk next 2 sts, 6 dc in next st; join with sl st in first sc.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail for sewing.

## JOINING

Hold 2 panels with WS together and sts matching. With yarn tail, sew panels together, stuffing before finishing seam.
Repeat with remaining panels to make 4 Clouds.

## SUN

## FRONT

With B, ch 2.
Rnd 1 (RS): Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook; do not join, work in continuous rnds (spiral).
Place a marker in last st made to indicate end of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.
Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in each st around - 12 sc.
Rnd 3: *Sc in next st, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around - 18 sc.
Rnd 4: *Sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around - 24 sc.
Rnd 5: *Sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around - 30 sc.
Rnd 6: *Sc in next 4 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around - 36 sc.
Rnd 7: *Sc in next 5 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around - 42 sc.
Rnd 8: *Sc in next 6 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around - 48 sc.
Rnd 9: *Sc in next 7 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around -54 sc.
Rnd 10: *Sc in next 8 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around - 60 sc.
Fasten off.

## BACK

Make same as Front but do not fasten off.

## JOINING

Hold Front and Back with WS together and sts matching.
Rnd 1: Working through both thicknesses, *sl st in next 2 sts, picot; rep from * around, stuff piece before completing rnd; join with slip st in first sl st.
Fasten off.

## RAINBOW

## FRONT

With C, ch 2.
Row 1: Work 8 sc in 2nd ch from hook; do not join, work back and forth in rows.
Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across and change to $D$ in last st.
Row 3: Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, sc in next st, *2 sc in next st, sc in next st; rep from * across - 12 sc .

Row 4: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across and change to $E$ in last st.
Row 5: Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, sc in next 2 sts, *2 sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts; rep from * across - 16 sc.
Row 6: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across and change to $F$ in last st.
Row 7: Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, sc in next 3 sts, *2 sc in next st, sc in next 3 sts; rep from * across -20 sc.
Row 8: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across and change to $G$ in last st.
Row 9: Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, sc in next 4 sts, *2 sc in next st, sc in next 4 sts; rep from * across - 24 sc.
Rows 10 and 11: Ch 1, sc in each st across.
Fasten off.

## BACK

Make same as Front, but leave a long yarn tail for sewing.

## TRIM

Row 1: From RS, join A with sl st in lower corner of Rainbow to work along lower edge, work 21 sc evenly spaced across lower edge of Rainbow.
Row 2: Ch 1, turn, working in back loops only, 6 dc in first st, *sk next st, sl st in next st, sk next st, 3 dc in next st; rep from * to last 4 sts, sk next st, sl st in next st, sk next st, 6 dc in last st.
Row 3: Turn to work in free loops of Row 1 (the front loops that were left unworked when Row 2 was made), sl st in first st, *sk next st, 3 dc in next st, sk next st, sl st in next st; rep from * across; sl st in first dc of Row 2.
Fasten off.

## JOINING

Hold Front and Back with WS together and sts matching. With yarn tail threaded into blunt needle, sew curved edges of Front and Back together.
Flip outer scalloped edge of trim up to cover lower part of Rainbow.
Sew lower edges together with A, stuffing before finishing seam.

## RAINDROPS (Make 5-1 each with C, D, E, F and G)

Ch 2.
Rnd 1: Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook; do not join, work in continuous rnds (spiral). Place a marker in last st made to indicate end of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.
Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in each st around - 12 sc.
Rnd 3: *Sc in next st, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around - 18 sc.
Rnds 4 and 5: Sc in each st around.
Rnd 6: *Sc in next st, sc2tog; rep from * around -- 12 sc.
Rnd 7: Sc in each st around.
Rnd 8: (Sc2tog) 6 times - 6 sc.
Stuff piece firmly.
Rnd 9: Sc in each st around
Rnd 10: (Sc2tog) 3 times - 3 sc .
Skip next st, sl st in next st to join top.
Fasten off.

## FINISHING

## JOIN HOOPS

Place the smaller hoop inside the larger hoop.
Cut a length of $A$.
Knot one end of length to the larger hoop, wrap around hoop a few time, then loosely tie to smaller hoop.
Adjust size of the yarn length as desired, then untie yarn from smaller hoop.
Once you've determined length you'd like, wrap and then knot the yarn length to the smaller hoop.

Cut strands of yarn in colors and lengths as desired.
Tie one end of each length to top of each Clouds, Raindrops, Sun, and Rainbow.
Attach each of these pieces to mobile by wrapping end of each yarn length around the hoop a few times and then knotting.
Don't trim the ends of the yarn lengths, you'll use them to make the hanging loop.

## HANGING LOOP

Bring the ends of the yarn lengths to the center above hoops.
Fold ends of strands to make a loop, then wrap with another length of yarn to secure and hide ends.

Weave in ends.
